Receiving a cleaning tip is a customer's way of saying job well done. Tips are always appreciated. General Rule is \$10-\$20 per cleaning depending on length of time.



How to clean laminate floors

Before you learn how to clean laminate floors, you'll need to prepare for battle. You are going to need a broom, mop and spray bottle with cleaning solution especially for laminate flooring. I use Bona for laminate floors.

First you need to remove any rugs. Next sweep floor clean of dust or dirt.

Now it's time to clean the floors. A flat terry cloth mop works best for this job. Lightly mist the laminate floor cleaning in a 4x8 area then mop side to side until clean.

A mixture of ¼ cup vinegar and warm water in a spray bottle makes an inexpensive cleaning solution. Spray a small amount on the floor and mop up immediately.

Windex can also be used to clean laminate floors. Spray a small amount in a 4x8 area and mop with terry cloth mop.

Never use wax or polish on laminate flooring. Never use abrasives. This includes steel wool or abrasive cleaners.

Don't let liquids stay on the floor for any length of time. If you have pet water dish on the floor consider placing a mat underneath it to catch any drips from Fido.
